EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 31, SERIES OF 2020

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER FURTHER EXTENDING THE PROVINCE-WIDE
GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (GCQ) IN THE PROVINCE OF
BOHOL FROM JUNE 16, 2020 TO JUNE 30, 2020 TO CURTAIL THE
THREATS OF COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND PARTLY AMENDING EXECUTIVE
ORDER 28 AND 28-A**

WHEREAS, on the 29th day of May, 2020, the undersigned Provincial Governor of Bohol, has issued Executive Order No. 28-A, Series of 2020, extending the province-wide General Community Quarantine (GCQ) in the Province of Bohol to curtail the continued threats of COVID-19 and partly amending Executive Order No. 28;

WHEREAS, the Inter-agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases issued Resolution No. 45, series of 2020, dated June 10, 2020, adopting the recommendations of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) on the proposed protocols for the reopening of dine-in food establishments;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Governor is empowered to issue such executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement of laws and ordinances and to carry out such emergency measures during and in the aftermath of man-made and natural disasters and calamities pursuant to Section 465 (b) (I) (vii) and Section 465 (b) (2) (iii) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, in relation to Section 4 (g) of RA 11469, otherwise known as the "*Bayanihan We Heal As One Act*", which provides that in addition to national standards of community quarantine, all Local Government Units (LGUs) are allowed to continue exercising their autonomy in matters undefined by the National Government or are within the parameters it has set; and are fully cooperating towards a unified, cohesive and orderly implementation of the national policy to address COVID-19;

WHEREAS, in view of the current realities and the threat of transmission of COVID-19, there is a need to further extend the Province-Wide General Community Quarantine in the Province of Bohol and continue the imposition of all quarantine measures, such as, but not limited to imposition of province-wide curfew and home quarantine, partial liquor ban, mandatory use of face masks, regulated operation of business establishments, the imposition of one-household-one-pass policy, while at the same time, reopened businesses will continue operating under the new normal in line with national standards;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the above premises, I, **ATTY. ARTHUR C. YAP**, Governor of the Province of Bohol, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

Section 1. Further Extension of the General Community Quarantine. – Consistent with national policy towards implementing a unified, cohesive and orderly program against COVID-19, the General Community Quarantine is hereby ordered to be further extended from **12:01 A.M. of 16 June 2020 until 11:59 of 30 June 2020.**

Section 2. Allowance for Dine-in Food Industry Operations. – Consistent with DTI recommendations, the gradual reopening of the food industry in the Province may begin on June 16, 2020 at 30% operational capacity, provided that venue capacity allows for social distancing protocols, and provided further, that such establishments are compliant with the proper protocols and minimum standards prescribed by the DTI and IATF, and subject to inspection and approval of the Mayor.


Establishments must obtain the required clearance from their respective City/Municipal Mayors to be allowed dine-in operations on a thirty percent (30%) capacity after showing compliance with the minimum health standards and guidelines imposed by the IATF and DTI.

Section 3. Public and religious gatherings. – Religious gatherings, including masses for fiesta celebration, shall be allowed but limited to twenty five percent (25%) of the venue or seating capacity. Celebration of fiestas shall continue to be held on a personal and private level.

Section 4. Repealing Clause. – All Executive Orders and other issuances which are inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed and modified accordingly.

Section 5. Effectivity. – This Executive Order shall take effect on 12:01 A.M. of 16 June 2020 and shall remain in force until revoked. However, Section 3 hereof shall be effective beginning 12:01 A.M. of Sunday 14 June 2020.
