AN EXECUTIVE ORDER FURTHER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 37 SERIES OF 2021 BY LIFTING THE SUSPENSION OF AIR AND SEA TRAVEL OF NON APORS BOUND FOR BOHOL FROM 12:01 OF SEPTEMBER 01, 2021 UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE, AND REIMPOSING THE PROVINCEWIDE PARTIAL LIQUOR BAN AS PROVIDED FOR IN EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17, SERIES OF 2020

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2021, the undersigned issued Executive Order No. 37, Series of 2021, directing a two (2)-week suspension of air and sea travel of passengers bound for Bohol, excluding domestic air and sea travel of cargoes, starting on 12:01 A.M. of Friday 6 August 2021 until 11:59 P.M. of Friday 20 August 2021;

WHEREAS, because of the continuing surge of COVID-19 in the whole country brought about by new variants of concern, particularly the Delta Variant, the said Executive Order was extended through Executive Order No. 40, Series of 2021, from 12:01 A.M. of August 21, 2021 until 11:59 P.M. of Tuesday August 31, 2021;

WHEREAS, during the Bohol IATF meeting on August 27, 2021 comprising the Mayors of Bohol, Bohol IATF Medical Task Group, the DILG, the Public Security Task Group and the officers of Provincial Tourism Council (PTC) and Bohol Association of Hotels, Resorts and Restaurants, (BAHRR), recommended the lifting of the air and sea travel of passengers who are classified as non-APOR subject to the same quarantine protocols as that of the OFWs under Section 2 of E.O. 37, from 12:01 A.M. of September 2021 onwards until further notice;

WHEREAS, also during the Bohol IATF meeting on August 30, 2021, it was agreed to reimpose a province wide liquor ban in order to minimize social gatherings of considerable number of people which would be the cause of further transmission of the virus;

WHEREFORE, premises considered, and by virtue of the powers vested in me as the Provincial Governor of Bohol under Section 465 (b), (2), (iii) of the Local Government Code (R.A. 7160) and other existing laws, **I, ARTHUR C. YAP**, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. LIFTING THE SUSPENSION OF AIR AND SEA TRAVEL OF PASSENGERS BOUND TO BOHOL WHO ARE NON APORS BEGINNING 12:01 OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2021 UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE - The suspension of air and sea travel of passengers bound for Bohol who are non-APORS, shall be lifted beginning 12:01 of September 1, 2021 until further notice.

SECTION 2. TESTING AND QUARANTINE PROTOCOLS FOR NON APORS- Non-APORS shall present a valid RT-PCR negative test result with swab or saliva sample taken not more than 72 hours prior to his/her departure to Bohol. Upon arrival, he or she shall be quarantined in an LGU approved public or privately owned quarantine facility for five (5) days. In the case of privately owned quarantine facility, it may be a DOT accredited accommodation establishment or any private facility/house/home with

separate rooms and Toilet Bath facility. On the fifth day of quarantine period, he/ she shall undergo repeat RT-PCR Test. If the result is negative, he / she shall be released, otherwise, if the result is positive, he/ she shall continue his/ her quarantine and may be allowed to go home only after his result yielded negative.

SECTION 3. CONTINUED APPLICABILITY AND EFFECTIVITY OF SECTIONS 2, 3 AND 4 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 37, SERIES OF 2021 - Sections 2, 3 and 4 of Executive Order No. 37, Series of 2021, on the testing and quarantine protocols for APORs, the strict enforcement of border control in all ports of entry, and the measures to be taken in case of violations, respectively, shall continue to be applicable and effective and shall be strictly enforced.

SECTION 4. REIMPOSITION OF PROVINCEWIDE PARTIAL LIQUOR BAN –
The provincewide partial liquor ban is hereby reimposed as provided for under Executive Order No. 17, Series of 2020, dated 24 March 2020, to wit:

“It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, furnish, offer, buy, serve or take alcoholic drinks and beverages, anywhere in the Province of Bohol, provided that:

- (1) Alcoholic drinks and beverages purchased for consumption at home, or in private premises shall be allowed;
- (2) The consumption of liquor within residential premises shall be limited to the dwellers of the said residence and it shall be prohibited for a person to proceed and congregate in another residence to consume and drink alcohol; and
- (3) It shall be prohibited for a person intoxicated or under the influence of liquor to go out of their residential premises or public places.

The Philippine National Police and the Barangay Officials are hereby directed to ensure strict implementation of the foregoing.”

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY- This Order shall take effect immediately upon its issuance.
