**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 52-B**  
Series of 2021

**AN ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER NOS. 52 AND 52-A, SERIES OF 2021,  
THEREBY TEMPORARILY ACCEPTING VACCINATION CARDS IN LIEU OF  
VACCINATION CERTIFICATES AND STREAMLINING TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS  
FOR VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS BOUND FOR BOHOL**

**WHEREAS**, the undersigned issued Executive Order No. 52, Series of 2021 lifting the requirement of a negative RT-PCR Test Result for fully vaccinated individuals upon their entry to the Province of Bohol and directing them to instead show Vaccination Certificates generated from the Government website **vaxcert.doh.gov.ph** and duly authenticated and validated by the Department of Health ("DOH")-Bureau of Quarantine ("BOQ") along with the S-Pass Travel Pass from the Department of Science and Technology ("DOST") website;

**WHEREAS**, the undersigned issued Executive Order No. 52-A, Series of 2021 temporarily allowing until 30 November 2021 the presentation of Vaccination Cards issued in the Province of Bohol along with Government-issued Identification Cards and S-Pass Travel Pass for those who could not secure Vaccination Certificates from **vaxcert.doh.gov.ph** for the reason that their vaccination records are still in the process of being uploaded in the said DOH website;

**WHEREAS**, the undersigned anticipates that City/Municipal Local Government Units ("LGUs") in the Province of Bohol and other parts of the country will not be able to finish uploading the vaccination records of individuals, thereby, resulting to inability to generate Vaccination Certificates from **vaxcert.doh.gov.ph** even until the fast-approaching Christmas Season;

**WHEREAS**, while there is a need to incentivize and encourage vaccination by giving fully vaccinated individuals the liberty of movement and travel, there is also a need to provide safeguards against proliferation of fake Vaccination Cards allowing unvaccinated individuals to travel without presenting negative RT-PCR Test Results;

**WHEREAS**, under Executive Order Nos. 52 and 52-A, Series of 2021, travelers are still required to present an approved S-Pass Travel Pass generated from the DOST website aside from their Vaccination Certificates/Cards and Government-issued IDs;

**WHEREAS**, because of the influx of travelers this *Undas* long weekend, Focal Persons of the component City/Municipal LGUs are currently swamped and are expected to be continuously swamped with requests for approval and issuance of S-Pass Travel Pass until the Christmas Season;

**WHEREAS**, while there is still a need to obtain S-Pass Travel Pass for recording and monitoring purposes, it is no longer the fault of the travelers if their requests remain pending and they should be allowed to travel upon complying with the Vaccination Card and Government-issued ID requirements;

**WHEREAS**, in consideration of the foregoing premises, the undersigned consulted with the Local Chief Executives of the component City/Municipal LGUs who arrived at a consensus to temporarily suspend the Vaccination Certificate requirement and accepting Vaccination Card in lieu thereof until the DOH website **vaxcert.doh.gov.ph** will be fully operational and to further streamline other travel requirements for vaccinated individuals bound for Bohol;

**WHEREFORE**, premises considered, and by virtue of the powers vested in me as the Provincial Governor of Bohol under Section 465 (b), (2), (iii) of the Local Government Code (R.A. 7160) and other existing laws, I, **ARTHUR C. YAP**, direct the **AMENDMENT OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NOS. 52 AND 52-A, SERIES OF 2021, THEREBY TEMPORARILY ACCEPTING VACCINATION CARDS IN LIEU OF VACCINATION CERTIFICATES AND STREAMLINING TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS FOR VACCINATED INDIVIDUALS BOUND FOR BOHOL**, as follows:

**SECTION 1. REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAVEL TO THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL.** – Effective immediately, Executive Order Nos. 52 and 52-A, Series of 2021, are hereby amended requiring only the following for fully vaccinated travelers to the Province of Bohol:

- a) Vaccination Card issued by any LGU, DOH-accredited medical institution, private company, and foreign country or any State/Province thereof authenticated by DOH-BOQ;
- b) Government-Issued Identification Card; and
- c) S-Pass Travel Pass (Approved or Pending Approval).

**SECTION 2. LIFTING OF THE PRIOR INDORSEMENT LIST REQUIREMENT.** – Effective immediately, the indorsement from the component City/Municipal LGUs to the Bohol Inter-Agency Task Force and ultimately to the Philippine Coast Guard /Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines of the list of approved travelers shall be lifted and will no longer be required. Travelers with complete requirements listed in Section 1 hereof shall be allowed to purchase airline or ship tickets and shall allowed to board and travel to the Province of Bohol.

**SECTION 3. S-PASS TRAVEL REQUIREMENT (APPROVED OR PENDING APPROVAL)** – For record and monitoring purposes, travelers are still required to apply for S-Pass Travel Pass. However, whether approved or pending approval, vaccinated travelers will be allowed to purchase airline or ship tickets, board, and travel upon presenting printed copies of either approved or pending approval S-Pass Applications along with their Vaccination Cards and Government-issued IDs.

**SECTION 4. SAFEGUARD AGAINST PROLIFERATION OF FAKE VACCINATION CARDS.** – The undertaking in the S-Pass Application of travelers shall bind them and shall be the basis of criminal prosecution should they utilize and submit tampered or falsified Vaccination Cards.

**SECTION 5. SEVENTY-TWO (72)-HOUR NEGATIVE RT-PCR TEST RESULT FOR UNVACCINATED TRAVELERS.** – Unvaccinated individuals shall be required to present a negative RT-PCR Test Result taken within seventy-two (72) hours prior to departure along with an approved S-Pass Travel Pass. Children four (4) years old and below shall remain exempted from this requirement.

**SECTION 6. REIMPOSITION OF THE VACCINATION CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENT.** – Allowing the use of Vaccination Card as a requirement for travel to the Province of Bohol shall be temporary. The Vaccination Certificate requirement shall be reimposed once the DOH website **vaxcert.doh.gov.ph** shall be rendered fully operational.

**SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY.** – This Executive Order shall be effective immediately until amended, modified, or superseded by another issuance.
