EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 64 Series of 2021

AN ORDER SUSPENDING CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS AND SUSPENSION OF WORK IN ALL GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE OFFICES IN THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL ON DECEMBER 16-17, 2021 DUE TO TYPHOON ODETTIE

WHEREAS, the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) has issued tropical cyclone bulletin placing Bohol under Storm Signal No. 2 due to Typhoon Odette;

WHEREAS, Typhoon Odette's movement is going west to west-northwestward from Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur and is forecasted to hit the whole of Central Visayas, including the province of Bohol on the early evening of December 16 up to the early morning of December 17, 2021 with torrential rains and strong winds;

WHEREAS, PAGASA thru the Regional DRRM Council has issued Storm Surge Watch bulletins, with recommendation for those residents in low-lying coastal communities to take extra precaution due to high waves and to stay away from the coastlines or beaches;

WHEREAS, the PDRRMC in its Pre-Disaster Risk Assessment conducted on December 14, 2021, has recommended to the Governor for the suspension of classes and work in all government and private offices within the Province of Bohol;

WHEREAS, to ensure primarily the safety of Boholano residents, and in order for them to be with their respective families in this hydrometeorological threat, preventive action must be undertaken;


NOW THEREFORE, I, ATTY. ARTHUR C. YAP, Governor of the Province of Bohol, by the powers vested in me by law and as recommended by the PDRRMC, do hereby order the **SUSPENSION CLASSES IN ALL LEVELS IN PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS AND THE SUSPENSION OF WORK IN ALL GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE OFFICES IN THE PROVINCE OF BOHOL** beginning 12:01AM of December 16, 2021 up to 11:59PM of December 17, 2021.

However, offices whose functions involve the delivery of health services, preparedness and response to disaster and calamities, and/or performance of vital functions shall continue with their operations.

Moreover, DepEd School Districts, through their District Supervisors or Principals, within the Province of Bohol, are directed to immediately prepare their school buildings, facilities and other resilient structures to serve as additional evacuation centers.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
